US: Right 6-9 o'clock segmental calcification & duct dilation, ill def patch like density 17*10 mm B6

MRI: Right retro 6 o'clock 8*4 mm B3, 7 o'clock MZ 10*8 B3

CNBx (Right 7 o'clock intraductal mass): DCIS high grade, ER 40%, PR negative, Ki67 10%

Repeat CNBx: DCIS high grade

FNA(Rt Ax LN): metastatic

Mets wu: Bilateral peripheral Lung Nodules 3-5 mm
