A 51 year-old woman with right breast locally advanced cancer who underwent neoadjuvant chemotherapy (8 sessions) PEx: locally advanced (T4) and right axillary ulcerated fix mass MG 99.7: suspicious spiculated right UOQ mass (B5) + suspicious LAP US: Right breast mass (B5) CT: Right breast mass (70mm) + Right axillary mass (45mm), No metastasis Bone Scan: 6/7th ribs are suspicious Breast CNB: IDC, G2, ER+ (10-20%), PR+ (20-30%), HER2 -, Ki67 30% LN FNA: positive MRV: Right axillary vein thrombosis, pectoralis major muscle involvement and right retro hemi thoracic mass

Systemic or local treatment?

Recommendation:

1. Left T7 involvement & thoracic mass with LD involvement (in imaging & MRV review)

2. She is not operable

3. Radiotherapy is not helpful because of ROM limitation

4. She should be referred to medical oncologist (continue systemic therapy with some other medication)
