Patient presentation: A 53-year old lady presented with left breast mass in 1399.

PMH: She has history of burn in 1389.

She underwent lumpectomy in 1399/4 with the diagnosis of phyllodes tumor.

Pathology: malignant phyllodes tumor & surgical margins are involved.

She underwent mastectomy in 1399/10.

She presented with mass in mastectomy bed in 1400/5 & 3 LNs in left axilla that underwent resection & ALND.

Pathology: malignant phyllodes & margins & LNs are free.

Now she has a large ulcerated mass in her surgery site.

CT: heterogenic mass 120*100 mm with necrotic region in left breast & mass in left axilla & vascular collateral in anterior & posterior of chest wall.

Palliative surgery.
