(IDC, ER+ 95%, PR+30%, HER2 2+, Ki67 9%)

Now presented with left axillary lymphadenopathy.

**Sonography 1400/9:** simple cyst in 1 o'clock, LN 9x 17mm in left axilla.

**CNB:** metastatic adenocarcinoma

**Question:**

Does she need chemotherapy?

**Recommendation:**

Primary site resection.
