MRI: 29*16 mm non-mass enhancement in 3 o'clock (B6)

5*3 mm enhancing focus at 4 o'clock (B4a)

5*5 mm enhancing focus at 7 o'clock (B4a)

Mastectomy vs BCT?

Recommendation:

Target US & wire guided excision are recommended & if not seen then BCS is recommended.
