Patient's Name: Sh.S

Patient presentation: A 29 year-old lady with lump sensation in her left breast since 3 months ago.

US: irregular heteroechoic spiculated vertical with intra mass calcification 35*16 mm 12-1 o'clock. Heteroechoic indistinct border region 38*20 mm and suspicious micro calcification 2-3o'clock (B4c)

MG: focal asymmetry with distortion & Parenchymal edge retraction at left UOQ which not spread out in focal spot view (B4b)

CNBx: FCC with UDH + foci of marked mixed inflammatory cells with micro abscess formation favor for mastitis calcification not identified

Since one month ago she has experienced joint pain, which diagnosed as rheumatologic disease (NSAIDS, Prednisolone and Colchicine started for her).

Question:

Diagnostic plan (rebiopsy, vac biopsy or open surgery?)

Recommendation:

Target sonography.
