**Patient's Name:**S.M

**Responsible Physician:** Dr.Ebrahimi

**Patient presentation:** A 29 year-old lady with a mass in her right breast since 4 months ago.

Firm mass with skin and nipple deformity , with a mobile axillary LAP.

**US:** spiculated hypoechoic mass with irregular border 30\*28, normal axilla

**MG:** irregular spiculated margin high density mass in right breast upper and central with microcalcification.

**CNBx:** IDC, G 1/3, ER 100% strongly +, PR 70 % weak to moderate, HER2 negative, Ki67:20-30%

**WBS :**Normal

**CT:** a 3.3 mm nodule in lateral of upper segment of right lower lobe. Multiple hypo dense liver masses in segments 3,4a and 6,which are too small .Dynamic MRI is recommended.

**Question:**

1. Are does lesions metastatic?
2. If not; what is the treatment order(surgery or chemotherapy at first step)?

**Recommendation:**

MRI then surgery.
