Bone scan: Normal

CT scan: some hypodense masses in liver probably hemangioma

Pathology of excisional mass: suspicious for metastatic carcinoma (more probably poorly differentiated thyroid carcinoma)

IHC: highly suggestive of carcinoma probably adenocarcinoma

Path review: cutaneous adenomyoepithelioma
