Mamo: an irregular focal asymmetry in right deep upper central& a linear microcalcification inferior and medial to the mentioned asymmetry B4c
MRI: 11 mm mass in 12 o'clock right breast with irregular margin B6
She underwent lumpectomy & SLNB
Pathology : multifocal IDC with some foci suggestive for tubular carcinoma, LVI -, PNI- , margin free, 1 SLN free, ER + 70 %, PR + 50 %, HER2 - , Ki67 7 %
