**CC:** right breast mass

**PE:** right 8 o'clock MZ to 11 o'clock NZ mass & thickness

**Mammography:** right UOQ asymmetry & microcalcification (B4b)

**Sonography:** right UOQ 48\*10 mm mass (B4b)

**MRI:** right lateral 8-10 o'clock NME 61\*34 mm B5

**CNB:** high grade DCIS

**Surgery:** right NSM, SLNB and tissue expander (superficial margin very close)

**Pathology:** high grade DCIS in most parts of breast, superficial margin is involved (More than 1 focus), ER & PR 50%, Ki67 30%, HER-2 negative

**SLN:** 0/3

**Question:**

1-Does she need to undergo skin resection & RTX?

2-Is adjuvant RTX sufficient in case of skin resection?

**Recommendation:**

Follow up and RTX consult.
