**Patient's Name:** M.M

**Patient presentation:** A 61 year-old lady with the history of DCIS 10 years ago that underwent nipple sparing mastectomy.

**Pathology:** IDC, 0/5 cm, G1, ER+, PR+, HER2 -, Ki67 10%, 8 LN negative  
She stopped using tamoxifen because of subdural hematoma & underwent brain surgery  
She presented with nipple ulcer & mass from 4 months ago.

**Breast imaging:** right breast B4, left breast B3, right axilla mass 32\*23 mm

**CNB:** encapsulated papillary carcinoma luminal A, Ki 67 7-10 %

**CT:** nodule in right lung, nodule in liver

**Question:**

What's the next plan?

**Recommendation:**

Evaluating contralateral breast, bone scan, upfront surgery and liver MRI are recommended.
