Patient presentation: A 71 year-old lady that underwent mastectomy in 1400/7.

Pathology: ILC, 4/7 cm, ER+, HER -, 4/26 LN involved , Ki67 10-15%
She had the history of nephrectomy. She underwent single agent chemotherapy (paclitaxel)

Bone scan: suspicious for metastasis (in review there was no metastasis)

CT: pulmonary nodules that reduced in size & number in follow up CT.

Question:

What's the next plan?

Recommendation:

XRT is recommended .CT scan before and after chemotherapy should be reviewed and if there was metastasis then XRT should be omitted.
