**Patient's Name:** T.B

**Responsible Physician:** Dr.Alipour

**Patient presentation:** A 44 year-old woman known case of left breast cancer

**Sonography:** A 40\*38\*29 mm mass at 1 o'clock of left breast (retronipple) (B5) and A 10\*6 mm mass at 2 o'clock of her left breast (far zone)

**Mammography:** macrolobulated mass in left her retronipple

**CNB:** IDC, Grade: 2, LVI: negative, ER: negative, PR: negative, HER-2: negative, Ki67:70-75%, LN: negative

Marker was inserted in both masses and NAC then BCS with guide wire and SLNB at 1400/7/18 and after surgery RT were done for her.

**Pathology:** pathologic complete response

No invasive or in situ tumor cells are present

Margin: free, SLN: 0/4, NSLN: 0/2

After treatment in follow up 2 weeks ago

**Mammography:** inserted markers are seen in 12 and 2 o'clock

**Sonography:** surgical markers are seen at 12-1 and 2 o'clock

1-Breast MRI

2-Genetic consult

3-If each one of the above results is positive mastectomy should be considered.
