**Patient's Name:** J.B

**Patient presentation:** A 77 year-old woman known case of right breast cancer that BCS, ALND, chemoradiotherapy and HRT with Letrozole were done for her 8 years ago

**Pathology:** IDC, Grade: 2, Size: 3.1 cm, DCIS: positive, Margins: free, LN: 1/8

ER: + 98%, PR: + 50%, HER-2: 2+ (CISH :-), Ki67:15%

She presented right upper limb lymphedema from 5 years ago

She had severe pain in right upper limbs from 4 months ago

**CT scan:** A 49\*47 mm mass in basal of neck with encasement of subclavian vessel and some LAPs in supraclavicular

**CNB:** degenerated nerve trunk with patchy inflammation

In a small focus infiltration of few atypical cells

What is the treatment plan?

### **Recommended plan:**

- 1-RT
- 2-Nerve block
- 3-Surgery was not recommended.
- 4-Tumor marker is requested.
