- Liver metastasis, Neoadjuvant chemotherapy then breast surgery and metastasectomy.

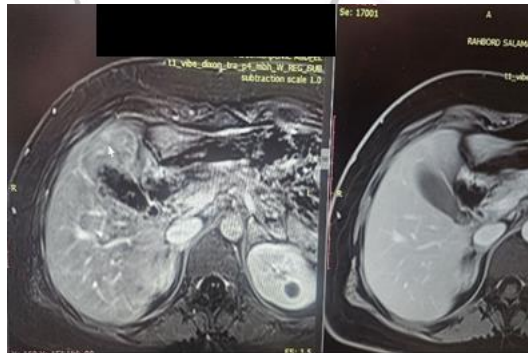


Figure 1: Liver MRI doesn't show any metastasis.
