Patient's Name: M.K

Patient presentation: A 45 year-old lady with FH of breast cancer in grandmother

PMH: She underwent left breast lumpectomy 11years ago.

Pathology: fibroadenoma

She presented with left breast mass UIQ about 2 cm in 1400.

Mammography: asymmetric increased density left retroareolar more prominent than before (B0)

Sonography: isoechoic structure retroareolar 14 mm (stable) B3

MRI: mass 8 mm in 4 o'clock, mass 4 mm 12 o'clock & 7 mm intramammary LN in 2 o'clock.

Soft tissue sonography: reactive LN 10*5 mm adjacent to left side of sternum

Thoracic & neck CT: two 5 mm subcutaneous nodules of upper anterior chest wall at the level of manubrium in contact with sternal head of left pectoralis major muscle.
