Patient presentation: A 35 year-old woman with family history of pancreatic cancer (her father) with complain of bloody discharge and in mammography, cancer of left breast (diffuse DCIS) was proven. She underwent Mastectomy and SLNB 1 month ago. **CNB:** Invasive (2*2 mm) and Insitu (19*15*15 mm) ductal carcinoma, Grade: 1, Lymph node: 0/4, ER: 80%, PR: 70%, HER-2: triple positive, Ki67: 60%.

Question:

Is adjuvant chemotherapy needed?

Is Herceptin recommended?

Recommended plan:

- 1- Review of pathology if this pathology proved, ovarian suppression and endocrine therapy is recommended.
- 2- There is no need to chemotherapy and Herceptin.
