Patient presentation: A 39 year-old woman, with locally advanced breast cancer(LABC), she completed her treatment 2 years ago (including surgery, chemotherapy and radiotherapy), after 8 months liver metastases in right lobe, she underwent liver metastasectomy, after 6 months metastases in left lobe (3.4 * 4.5 * 5 cm), this time surgery was not possible due to vascular invasion and she was candidate for Stereotactic Body Radiation Therapy (SBRT), after SBRT CT scan was done.

1-What is the treatment plan?

After review of imaging, multiple liver metastases were detected and systemic therapy is recommended.

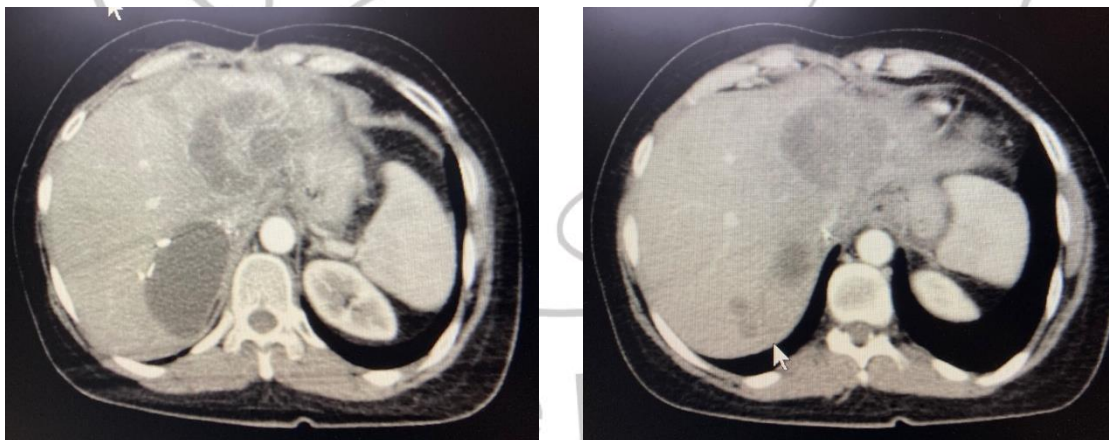


Figure 1 and 2: MULTIPLE METASTASES IN LIVER
