Patient presentation: A 33 year-old woman with negative family history and right breast cancer.

Pathology: IDC, ER: weakly positive, PR: negative, Ki67: 75-80%, HER-2 <10% few cells are strongly positive (3+).

Sonography: Mass, 30*29 mm, at 1 o'clock, BIRADS: 5.

Mammography: Mass, 31*17 mm, in UIQ, suspicious lymph adenopathy (LAP), 22*12 mm, in the right axilla.

CNB: negative.

Question:

What is the treatment plan? Should it be upfront surgery or neoadjuvant chemotherapy?

Recommended plan:

- 1-Upfront surgery.
- 2-Recheck of HER-2 on permanent pathology.
