**Patient presentation:** A 62 year-old woman with right breast cancer from 4 years ago that underwent breast-conserving surgery (BCS) and sentinel lymph node biopsy (SLNB), (ILC, ER: 90%, PR: 20 %). She underwent Intra Operative Radiotherapy (IORT), Letrozole and neoadjuvant chemotherapy. Now she has local recurrence on the past surgery site.

**CNB:** IDC, ER: negative, PR: negative, HER-2: triple positive, Ki67: 2-3%.

**Question:**

What is the treatment plan? Should it be upfront surgery or neoadjuvant chemotherapy?

**Recommended plan:**

After review of the documents, this setting is a new primary tumor and neoadjuvant chemotherapy and review of IHC is suggested.
