CNB: ER: 90%, PR: 100%, HER-2: triple positive, Ki67: 40%.

METs W/U:

Bone scan: Right sacroiliac joint is suspicious.

Breast MRI: Nonmass enhancement in left breast.

Question:

Does she need prophylactic mastectomy?

Is the sacroiliac joint suspicious for METs?

Recommended plan:

- 1- Sacroiliac joint is DJD, it's not METs.
- 2- There is no need to prophylactic mastectomy.
