Patient presentation: A 41 year-old woman with negative family history, known case of right breast cancer. In 1397 after NACT, right wire guided BCS, ALND and HRT was done for her. In 1401.3: Right huge breast mass & skin edema was found.

Sonography: Right multiple B5 masses up: 54mm, right axillary lymph node negative, no masses in left breast, left axillary multiple conglomerated lymph nodes.

Mammography: Is not done.

PET scan: No METs, recurrence in right breast & left axillary lymph node involvement.

CNB right breast: IDC, Grade: 3, ER: 10%, PR: negative, HER-2, 3: positive, Ki67: 50%.
Left axillary lymph node: involved

Question:

Does she need mastectomy?

Recommended plan:

Left breast mastectomy is preferred.
