Patient presentation: A 51 year-old woman with left breast cancer underwent BCS and SLNB (negative in frozen section).

CNB: IDC, luminal A, ER: 90%, PR: 90%, HER-2: negative, Ki67: 15%.

Pathology: 1 out of 5 lymph nodes was involved and 2 lymph nodes have micro-metastasis.

Ph/E and sonography of axilla: Normal without any suspicious lymph nodes.

Question:

According to adjuvant chemo-radiotherapy, is the axillary dissection necessary?

Recommended plan:

There is no need to ALND, she is referred to radio-oncologist.
