Patient's Name: L.T

Patient presentation: A 43 year-old woman with right BCS and SLNB (2 free lymph nodes) at 1400/10. She underwent 2 courses of adjuvant chemotherapy (ACH regime) on 1401/1 and 1401/2, due to economic reasons she stopped chemotherapy, after 6 months, she returned to continue the treatment.

CNB: IDC, Mass 8 o'clock, 2cm, ER: 80%, PR: negative, HER-2: positive, Ki67: 25%, Grade: 3, LVI: negative, PNI: positive.

New breast US: Right and left breast: B2.

New breast MG: Right: B2, left: B0.

New PET scan: Suspicious of local recurrence in UOQ of right breast.

PH/E: Breast and axilla are both normal.

Question:

What is the plan to continue adjuvant treatment?

Is it likely to be local recurrence?

Recommended plan:

According to passing of more than 3 months from previous chemotherapy, chemotherapy is not recommended, but continuing adjuvant endocrine therapy including Herceptin and Radiotherapy is recommended.

In the review of PET scan and breast imaging, local recurrence was not probable.

Left FCMV for suspicious distortion in left breast (B0).
