PET scan: Complete response.

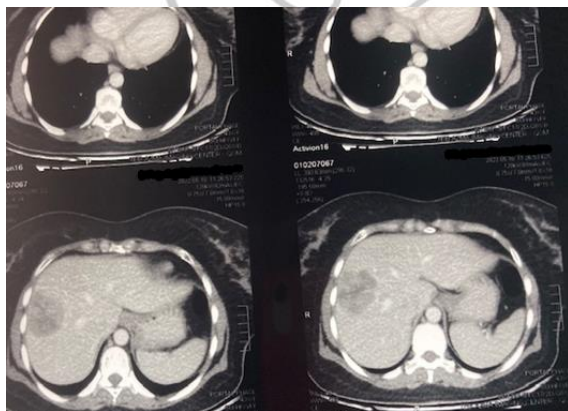
PH/E: Breast and axilla were both clear.

Question:

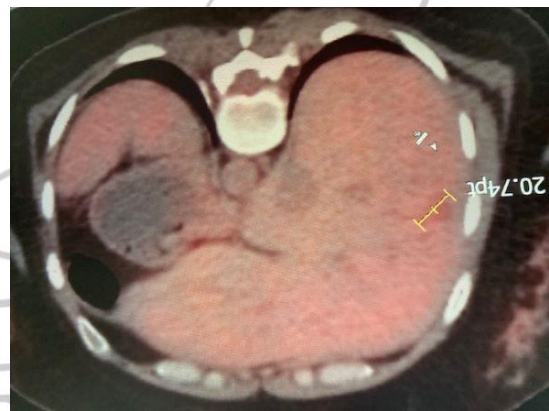
According to the response to neoadjuvant chemo-radiotherapy, is concurrent surgery of breast and liver metastatectomy indicated?
