Patient's Name: F.F

Responsible Physician: Dr.Omranipour

Patient presentation: 53 year-old woman with breast cancer and positive family history of breast cancer in her sister, underwent left BCS and ALND 3 weeks ago.

CNB: luminal B, ER: 80%, PR: 80%, HER-2: negative, Ki67: 30%.

Pathology: IDC: 80% and lobular feature: 20%, 3/8 of lymph nodes were involved with extranodal extension, Grade: 1, T: 2.8 cm, DCIS was present (negative for EIO)

Margin: lateral margin very close to DCIS, just not touched ink margin and superficial margin very close to invasive component, just not touched inked margin, pT2pN1a

Question:

What is the treatment plan?

If surgery is needed, should it be re-excision or she must be referred to adjuvant radiotherapy?

Recommended plan:

There is no need to re-excision, she is referred to radiotherapy and breast MRI 1 week after, due to ruled out of other lesion due to lobular feature.
