Patient presentation: A 63 year-old woman with history of right breast cancer since 26 years ago (Right MRM, IDC, ER: positive, PR: negative, HER-2: negative, 0/8 lymph node), 7 years after surgery, she had recurrence in her chest wall (bed of mastectomy) that it was excised and radiotherapy was done. She was under treatment with Tamoxifen. Now she returned with right axillary recurrence.

CNB: IDC, ER: 100%, PR: 10%, HER-2: negative, Ki67: 20%.
